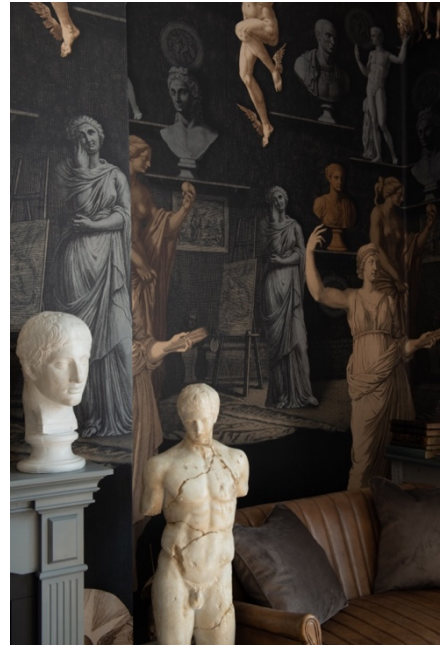

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Blossfeldt's Art Forms - Celebrating a world of photography, collecting and displaying, the BLOSSFELDT'S ART FORMS design welcomes you into a realm of discovery, where delving into plant specimens and botany is akin to adventure. Detailed photographs of leaves, stems, buds and petals have been magnified, highlighting their sculptural forms and reminding us that there's a whole universe of nature out there to explore and reimagine. Each image has been pinned or clipped in place, creating a 3D appearance of layers of photographs adorning the wall.

Ceramic Wonders - Shelves stacked full with antique treasures, CERAMIC WONDERS pays homage to the skill of ancient potters. Breathe in the scents of the Silk Road with pieces of porcelain, bedecked in Eastern promise and mystique, and admire the individual beauty and craft behind each vessel. From far away landscapes to prowling animals and exotic florals, each object on display is covered in narrative, telling its story in the swish and flick of a paintbrush. Available in a light or dark tone, the pattern is backed with an indigo and white floral traditional to ceramics, enhancing the wallpaper's three-dimensional effect and allowing jars and pots of all shapes and sizes to at once blend into the background, and stand proud.

Rare Artifacts - Are you walking your own halls, or admiring the riches of a lofty museum? The wonders of Ancient Rome have been collected and put on display for your viewing pleasure, there's no need to leave the house. Wonder at the detailing of fabric-wrapped statues, climb to the top of decorative columns and run with the chariots in intricate carved reliefs, with only the finest pieces brought to your attention. RARE ARTIFACTS creates a cabinet of curiosities, worthy of the most audacious emperor.

Old Tools - Welcome to the workshop, where all projects start, great ideas take shape, and the scent of freshly sanded wood and polished leather fills the room. OLD TOOLS showcases the beauty of the everyday equipment that is often overlooked in favour of what it goes on to create. Study and celebrate the power and design intricacies of each tool, with characterful line drawings immortalising even the smallest implement on a dark Anthracite or a pale cream backdrop. The pattern presents grain-decorated wooden mallets, complex clamping systems, hammers of all shapes and sizes and standalone single screws, all meticulously labelled and ready for any job imaginable.

Statuary Chamber - Enter the upper realms of ancient Roman society with STAUARY CHAMBER, a pattern filled with illustrative depictions of the faces of the era. A gathering of mythological god-like personalities and mortal neoclassical figures walk among each other, quietly emerging from the dark backdrop in subtle grey, bright ivory and off-white parchment tones, filling the room with finely tuned refinement. Bring the wallpaper to life and into the three dimensional with busts and statues of your own.

The Mood Board - MOOD BOARD celebrates the joy in recording, collecting and displaying that which inspires and captivates you. Pinterest, be gone – here we delight in the physical act of sketching, cutting and sticking, with the pattern echoing the tactility of paper affixed to the wall. Hand drawn studies of figures, flora and fauna, details and drawing techniques are recognised for their expressive, decorative qualities and combined into a beguiling design full of life and narrative, in gentle monochromes and the sepia tones of time-aged paper and tape.

The Studio - The artist's studio is a private space full of mystery, a room reserved for free thinking, experimentation and expression. THE STUDIO is a gathering of inspiration pasted to the wall, showcasing thoughts starting to form and the spark of creativity visualised. From quick, scribbled sketches to photo-realistic drawings, the pattern is a cacophony of creative concepts compiled to encourage more ideas to flow. Choose from dramatic black and white, or the soft tones of timeworn paper to line the walls with intriguing originality.
